CURRENT ASSIGNMENT: Assigned to US Africa Command, Mr. James Cashwell is the Deputy, Intelligence Directorate-Molesworth (J2-M), United Kingdom.

PAST EXPERIENCE: Mr. James Cashwell started his career with the Defense Department in 1979 when he enlisted in the US Army Reserves as a Medic for the 56th Station Hospital, Richmond, VA. In 1983 he entered active duty as an Armor officer and was assigned to Fort Hood Texas where he served as both a Tank and Scout Platoon Leader. His first overseas tour was with the 3rd Armored Division where he commanded an M1A1 Tank Company in the Fulda Gap. Returning to the United States, Mr. Cashwell served as an Instructor at Fort Knox, a Personnel Assignment Officer in the Army's Human Resource Command, and following Command & General Staff College he served as both the Operations and Executive Officer for the 10th Mountain Divisions' Cavalry Squadron. At Fort Lewis he commanded the Army's first Stryker Reconnaissance, Surveillance and Target Acquisition Squadron, followed by both a tour with the J-8, Joint Staff, Washington D.C. and as the Senior Advisor to the Deputy Minister for Security Forces, Ministry of Interior, Baghdad Iraq. Mr. Cashwell completed his career with the US Army as the Commander, Intelligence Fusion Center (supporting NATO) located at RAF Molesworth, England. Retiring from the Army in October 2009 in the rank of Colonel, he began his current assignment with the Defense Intelligence Agency.
